A giraffe eats leaves from trees. It doesn't need to drink much water, because it gets water from the leaves.

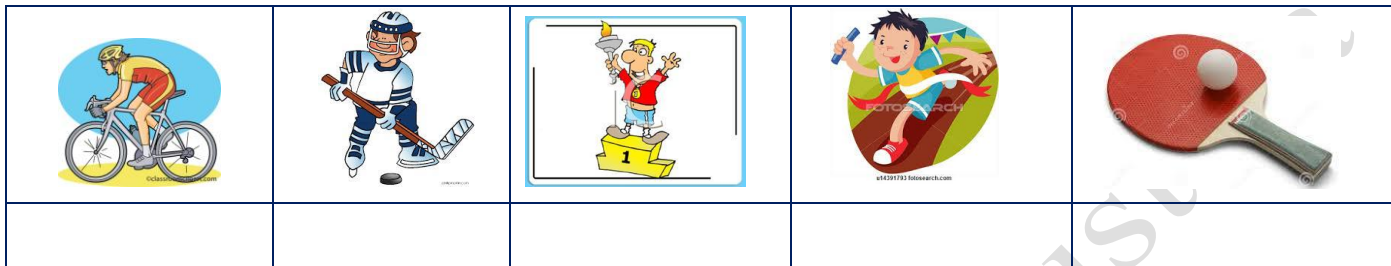
