John is 14. He doesn't want to live with a family and he would like to do as much sport as possible.

A

Royal School is a medium-sized school near the town centre. It is open throughout the year and offers courses at all levels. It organizes week-end excursions and sport programs during the summer. Students live with local families and have all their meals with them except weekday lunches which are provided by the school.

B

Queen's School is a beautiful old house on the edge of the city. The minimum age is 16 years and all the courses require students to be resident. There are special business classes to prepare students for working in an English-speaking work environment. Students get together in the evenings for a variety of activities. All levels welcome.

C

Milton School is a modern school offering activity-centered courses so that each day students combine language lessons with sport and cultural visits to nearby places of interest. The school is in the countryside but has its own transport. All students share study bedrooms.

D

International School is a large school in the city centre which offers all students single study-bedrooms within the school. Special attention is paid to each student's progress and extra individual lessons are included in a student's program. All levels accepted.

E

Grove School is a new language school offering courses for people with special interests in history, music, theatre and literature. Small classes plus a full social program during the week. Students live with selected families and are expected to take part in family life at weekends.

F

Bright School is a modern language school offering special courses for young people who are interested in science and technology. There are special programs during the week. All levels accepted.
