Present Perfect Simple

Present Perfect Simple: I/you/we/they **have + Past Participle**
 He/She/It **Has + Past Participle**

Affirmative: Ex: They **have gone** to London
 He **has gone** to London

Negative: Ex: They **haven't** gone to London.
 He **hasn't** gone to London.

Interrogative: Ex: Have **they gone** to London?
 Has **he gone** to London?
