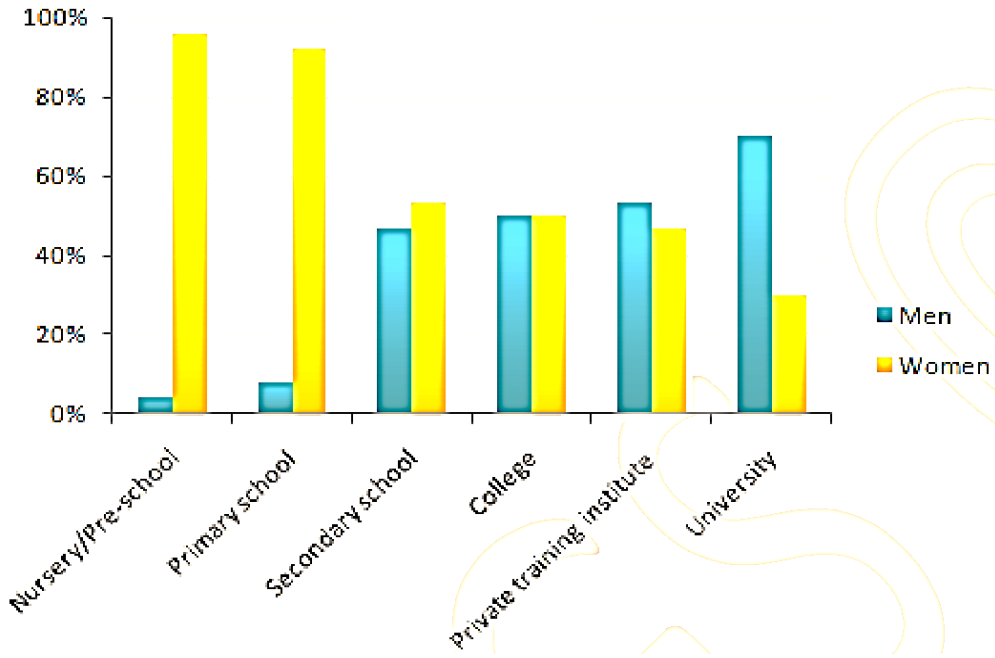

The bar chart gives information about the (1) \_\_\_\_\_ of teachers in (2) \_\_\_\_\_ types of educational institutions in the UK in (3) \_\_\_\_\_. It shows what percentage of teachers was (4) \_\_\_\_\_ and what percentage was (5) \_\_\_\_\_.

Women dominated the teaching profession in (6) \_\_\_\_\_ education, but less so at lower and upper secondary education. It was particularly true of nursery school, where the share of female teachers was above (7) \_\_\_\_\_. Similarly, one-sided was the situation in primary school, where over 90% of teachers were also female. At secondary and upper secondary level this pattern was less pronounced, where there were nearly (8) \_\_\_\_\_ percentage of male and female teachers. On the other hand, male teachers outnumbered female teachers in high-level education, where the proportion of men was twice that for women.

Overall, the higher the level of education, the more male teachers dominated, and the reverse occurred with respect to female teachers.
