### The Hajj

The word 'Hajj' in Arabic means '**pilgrimage** to Mecca'. The Hajj is the biggest **annual** pilgrimage in the world. Every year, around 3 million people take part in the Hajj. **This life changing** journey is the fifth pillar of Islam. Islam states that every **able-bodied** Muslim must make the journey at least once in their lifetime.

While in Mecca for the Hajj, males wear a **traditional** item of clothing called an 'ihram'. This is two pieces of cloth which they wrap around the body. Females wear clothes that cover their whole body but not their face. Dressing like this shows that all people are **equal** in the eyes of Allah.

During the Hajj, Muslims take part in **religious ceremonies**. The greater Hajj (al-hajj al-akbar) begins on the 7th day of the Islamic **sacred** month, which is the last month of the **lunar** calendar. On this day, everyone leaves Mecca to travel to the town of Mina. Then on the 9<sup>th</sup> day, they head towards Mount Arafat and spend the day **there**. After sunset, they leave for Muzdalifah where they can gather **pebbles** for the **stoning** of the Jamraat. On the 10th day of the month (Eid ul-Adha), they return to Mina where they throw seven pebbles at the large Jamrah.
